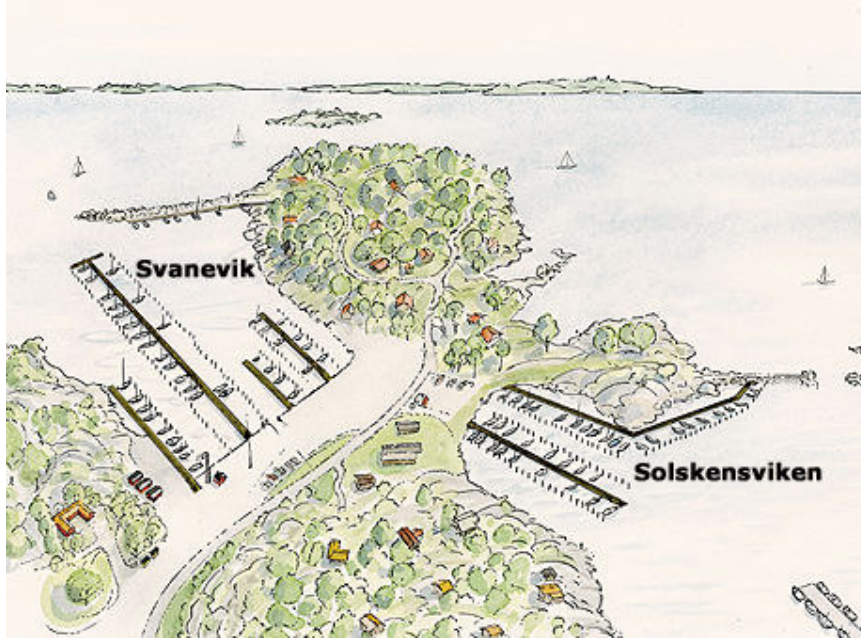


SVANEVIKS BRYGGFÖRENING WISH YOU WELLCOME TO OUR HARBOUR

We wish to provide some brief information about the harbour and town that might make your visit here a little easier.

The harbour

The harbour is owned by the town of Karlshamn and it has about 350 places for boats. Much of the practical work in the harbour is done by members of our society in cooperation with the local government.



Available places for guest boats

Svaneviks Bryggförening can use all green marked places on the bridges in as well Svanevik as Solskensviken (starboard directly after arrival in the Fishermans harbour) and all other places that are pointed out to you by the harbour host.

Harbour host

He is to be found in the harbour area Monday - Friday between about 8-11 and 13 – 15 a clock.

On weekends other members of our society partly replaces him.

Harbour dues

The harbour dues are regular 120 SEK per boat and night. On the outside of the caisson big boats pays 170 SEK. If you stay a whole week you pay only for 6 days. The dues are to be paid to the harbourhost, at best in the clubhouse or when he comes to your boat. You get a receipt and the dues will be marked on the boat with a different colour each day.

Electricity and water

Connections for 230 V electricity and (drinking)water are available on all bridges. It is free of charge for guest-boats.

Showers and toilets

Toilets are situated in the front and showers in the back side of the south building between the two bays. In the end of the building there is a toilet for disabled persons.

Garbage and wastes

A place to get rid of genereal garbage is situated along the street about 100 meters to the north of the harbour area. Nearby the derrick there is also a pump where you can drain your toilettank.

Bicycles

Our society has some small and big old bicycles that you might borrow without any costs. They and the keys are available from the harbour host.

Derrick

A derrick is available at Svanevik and can be used by members and guestboats without any costs. The electrical motor is only allowed to use by authorised members.

Repairs and equipment

In the area at Vägga near the guestharbour there are several firms which offer you a range of services. Just tell the harbour host or your boatneighbours about your problems and what you might be in need of.

The clubhouse

Our clubhouse is usually open and available for the boatguests in the daytime. In the clubhouse you can make easy cooking (don't forget washing up and cleaning). You can also find books, boatjournals, touristinformation, seacharts and so on. In most cases you can meet members who might give you some tip during your visit in our archipelago.

Weather

A weatherforecast for boats in the neighbourhood is to be found in the clubhouse.

Washing cloths

Not far away, at Kolleviks Camping, you can rent washing equipment. Ask the harbourhost how to go there.

Shopping, restaurants etc

In the clubhouse you can find some tourist information concerning shopping, restaurants, different tourist attractions etc.

In a walking distance in the Vägga-area there are two restaurants and a smokehouse with a variety of delicatessen foods.

Tourist information centre

Is situated in the centre of the town at Ronnebygatan, close to the town harbour.

Computer and Internet

In our harbour there is a wireless Internet that you can use without any costs. You can receive the password from the harbour host. In the clubhouse there is also an old computer that is free to use without any password.

Clubjournal

Our society has a plain journal that is sent to every member twice a year.
